PARTIES

- Patrick Dorais (Complainant) brings this Petition to Revoke Probation solely in his
 official capacity as the Chief of the Bureau of Automotive Repair (Bureau), Department of
 Consumer Affairs.
- In 2002, the Bureau issued Automotive Repair Dealer Registration Number ARD
 225167 to Issa Sallba Maymoun, dba Smog All (Respondent). The Automotive Repair Dealer
 Registration expired on December 31, 2022, and has not been renewed.
- 3. On or about December 23, 2002, the Bureau issued Smog Check, Test Only, Station License Number TC 225167 to Issa Sallba Maymoun, dba Smog All (Respondent). The Smog Check, Test Only, Station License expired on December 31, 2022, and has not been renewed.
- 4. On or about November 9, 2012, the Bureau issued Smog Check Inspector License Number EO 145531 to Issa Sallba Maymoun (Respondent). The Smog Check Inspector License was in effect at all times relevant to the charges brought herein and will expire on December 31, 2024, unless renewed.
- 5. On or about November 9, 2012, the Bureau issued Smog Check Repair Technician License Number EI 145531 to Issa Sallba Maymoun (Respondent). The Smog Check Repair Technician License expired on December 31, 2014, and has not been renewed.
- 6. In a disciplinary action titled *In the Matter of Accusation Against: Smog All, Issa S. Maymoun, Owner, Issa Sallba Maymoun, and Jalal Issa Haddad*, Case No. 79/18-1079, the Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs (Director) for the Bureau, issued a decision and order, effective July 18, 2019, in which Respondent's Automotive Repair Dealer Registration No. ARD 225167, Smog Check, Test Only, Station License No. TC 225167, Smog Check Inspector License No. EO 145531, and Smog Check Repair Technician License No. EI 145531, were revoked. However, the revocations were stayed and Respondent's Registration and Licenses were placed on probation for a period of five (5) years with certain terms and conditions. A copy of that decision and order is attached as Exhibit A and is incorporated by reference.

JURISDICTION

7. This Petition to Revoke Probation is brought before the under the authority of the decision and order *In the Matter of Accusation Against: Smog All, Issa S. Maymoun, Owner, Issa Sallba Maymoun, and Jalal Issa Haddad*, Case No. 79/18-1079. Probation Term and Condition 7 states:

Violation of Probation. If a Respondent violates or fails to comply with the terms and conditions of probation in any respect, the Director, after giving notice and opportunity to be heard may set aside the stay order and carry out the disciplinary order provided in the decision. Once Respondent is served notice of BAR's intent to set aside the stay, the Director shall maintain jurisdiction, and the period of probation shall be extended until final resolution of the matter.

8. On or about July 5, 2023, the Board requested the Attorney General's Office to prepare a Petition to Revoke Probation against Respondent's licenses, thereby automatically extending the probationary period, which shall not expire until the Petition has been acted upon by the Board.

CAUSE TO REVOKE PROBATION

(Failure to Maintain Valid License)

9. At all times after the effective date of Respondent's probation, Condition 8 stated:

Maintain Valid License. Respondents shall, at all times while on probation, maintain a current and active registration and/or license(s) with BAR, including any period during which suspension or probation is tolled. If a Respondent's registration or license is expired at the time the decision becomes effective, the registration or license must be renewed by the Respondent within 30 days of that date. If a Respondent's registration or license expires during a term of probation, by operation of law or otherwise, then upon renewal the Respondent's registration or license shall be subject to any and all terms and conditions of probation not previously satisfied. Failure to maintain a current and active registration and/or license during the period of probation shall also constitute a violation of probation.

- 10. Respondent's probation is subject to revocation because he failed to comply with Probation Condition 8, referenced above. The facts and circumstances regarding this violation are as follows:
- a. Respondent's Automotive Repair Dealer Registration No. ARD 225167 and Smog Check Station License No. TC 225167 expired on December 31, 2022, and have not been renewed.
