19	(1) Making or authorizing in any manner or by any means whatever any
20	statement written or oral which is untrue or misleading, and which is known, or which by the exercise of reasonable care should be known, to be untrue or misleading.
21	(4) Any other conduct which constitutes fraud.
22	(5) Conduct constituting gross negligence.
23	(6) Failure in any material respect to comply with the provisions of this
24	chapter or regulations adopted pursuant to it.
25	(b) Except as provided for in subdivision (c), if an automotive repair
