- Attending and presenting at high school and post-secondary career fairs.

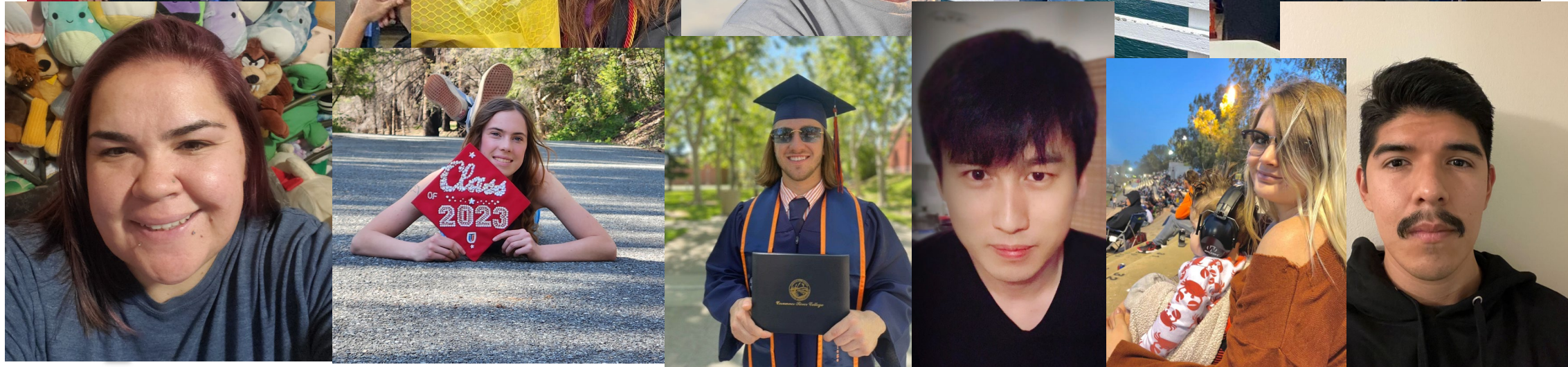
DID YOU KNOW?

Since 1998, the ASC Educational Foundation has awarded \$228,750 worth of scholarships to 203 students!

Through its successful Cars4Careers program, ASCEF turns donated cars into education and training for individuals wanting a career in the automotive service industry. Each year, ASCEF awards scholarships ranging from \$500 – \$1,000 to high school seniors who plan to enroll in post-high school technical/academic training or college undergraduates in the automotive service field. Since the establishment of the Foundation in 1998, ASCEF has awarded \$228,750 in scholarships.
