# **Program Overview**

Through this program, BAR provides retired CAP vehicles to publicly funded automotive technical training programs operated by:

- High Schools
- Community Colleges
- Regional Occupational Programs

#### Subject to availability, schools may request:

- The year, make, and model of vehicle desired
- Manual transmission or automatic transmission
- Diesel, gas, or hybrid
- Other options

# History/Current Status


#### **2020-22 Startup and Pandemic Delays**


- Cars for Schools provided its first vehicle in January 2020
- Program expansion stopped at 12 schools in March 2020 due to pandemic related school closures
- Program expansion resumed in July 2022

### July 2022 Expansion

- Currently 39 schools (13 community colleges, 5 regional occupational programs, and 20 high schools) have signed memorandums of understanding with BAR
- 68 vehicles have been assigned to schools
- Six of the assigned vehicles are hybrids

### Feedback from Instructors

### Vehicles are used for the following purposes

- Lecture Demonstration
- Student Practice (Remove/Replace, Repair, Diagnostic Routines)
- Training Category: General Repair, Smog Check, Auto Body, and Introduction to Hybrid Technology

### **Reasons Instructors Like Program**

- May choose from a range of different vehicles depending on class needs
- Don't need to worry about damaging vehicle (provided all parts are returned)
- Can bring vehicles back and order others from year to year
- Low cost

### **Requests for Improvement**

- Need help to transport vehicles to the schools
  - Provide discounted towing services and more time to pick up
- Provide a report prior to pick up of reason for retirement and condition of vehicle
- Provide more vehicles to each school
- Work on lowering wait time for rarer vehicles

### Plans for Future Improvement

- Continue outreach and increase the number of participating schools
- Explore ways to provide schools with discounted towing/transport
- Explore ways to provide schools with basic reports on vehicle condition at time of offer
- Explore ways to increase the number of vehicles provided
- Partner with educators and automotive repair industry on ways to improve the program
